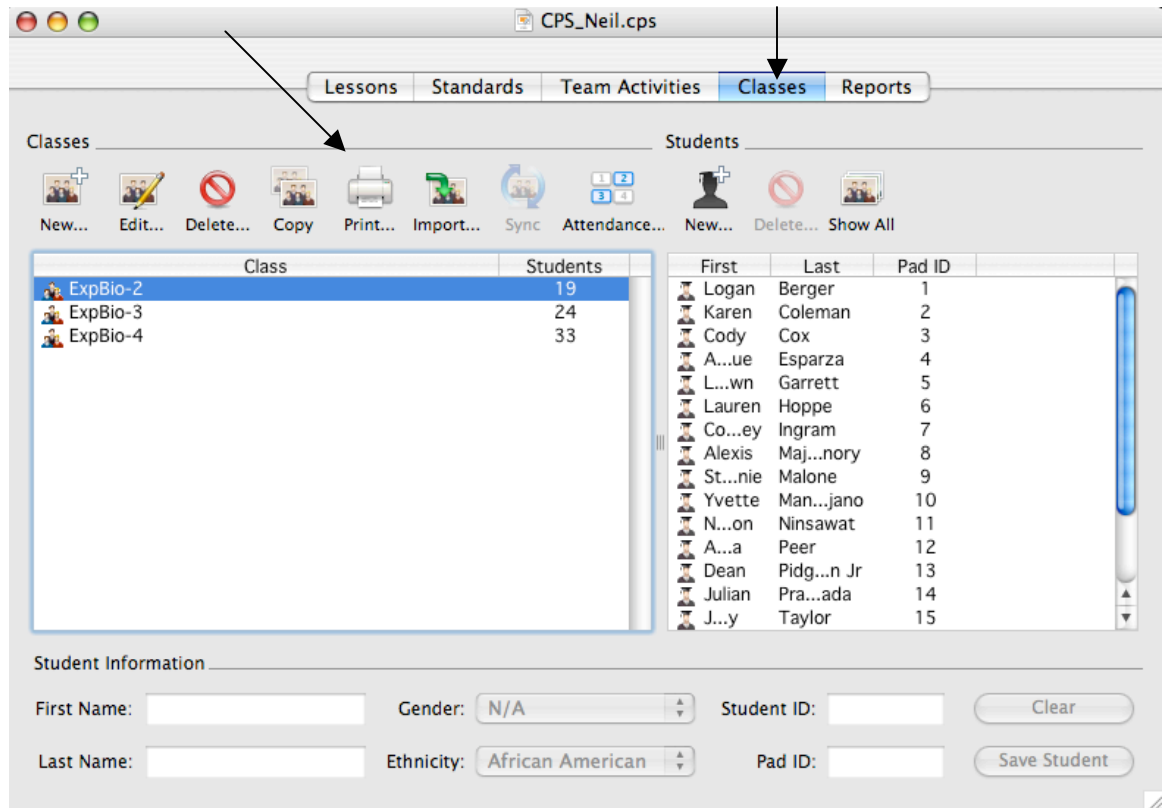




To print your class lists in CPS:

1. Click the CLASSES tab, select the class that you want to print, click PRINT. A dialog box will open that will allow you to print your class lists. Click PRINT.
