



Continuity of Learning Plan Revision

January 12, 2021

Metric for Returning to In-Person (Tracking from January 1, 2021)

Elementary Students and Middle School Students: The later of a weighted 14-day average of daily new cases from School of Choice municipalities of 9 or fewer, or January 25, 2021.

High School Students: The later of a weighted 14-day average of daily new cases from School of Choice municipalities of 5 or fewer, or January 25, 2021.

Regardless of this metric, all levels will provide an option for in-person schooling on March 1, 2021, whichever is earlier. Southgate Community School District will follow all state and local health department mandates for returning to school.

Metric for Staying In-Person

Case by case determination using the Wayne County School and District Spread Indicators and Risk Assessment and Southgate Community Schools school-associated case data. The Southgate Community School District will follow all state and local health department mandates for suspending in-person schooling options.

Modes of Instruction: Remote and virtual until the metric is reached. In-Person, Remote, and Virtual once the metric is reached.

Elementary and Middle School In-Person

Week One

AM Half-Days M, T, TH, F – All in-person students with in-person teacher

PM Half-Days M, T, TH, F – Asynchronous

Wednesday - Asynchronous

After Week One

M, T, TH, F – All in-person students full-day with in-person teacher

Wednesdays Asynchronous with in-person teacher

High School In-Person

M, T, TH, F – All in-person students full-day
Wednesday Synchronous Remote

Elementary Remote

M, T, TH, F – Synchronous remote with remote teacher
Wednesday Asynchronous remote with remote teacher

Week One – Remote will be asynchronous for M, T, and W (January 25 – 27).

Middle School and High School Remote

M, T, TH, F – Live Stream into In-Person Classes
Wednesday Synchronous Remote

Elementary, Middle School, High School Virtual – Atlas

These courses are self-paced and can be accessed at any time during the day/night. Students are required to meet twice per week (at minimum) with the Atlas teacher. Students will have two classes every six weeks (grades 6-12).
